

EMMETT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
REGULAR MEETING
MAY 10, 2017

The May meeting was called to order by the Supervisor at 7:00 p.m. and was followed by the pledge to the flag.

Roll call was taken with members Heiden, Reliford, Brown and Butler present, Kot was absent.

The May consent agenda was approved with a motion by Heiden and support by Reliford. The agenda motion was approved and consisted of the April board of trustees minutes, the April financial statement which included \$74,491.08 in CD's, revenue sharing savings account of \$296,495.72, park & recreation account of \$7,082.62, trust and agency account of \$7,002.24 building account of \$1,193.48, building insp. of \$16,626.68 and the general fund balance of \$7,609.59.

Supervisor Butler asked Reliford to take care of the posting of information on the sign in front of the Township Hall for which she accepted the duty.

Heiden made a motion to accept the Zoning map amendment of Mobile Home/Manufactured Home Park district MHP to Agricultural District AG as per the recent referral and approval by St. Clair County Metropolitan Commission. Reliford supported the motion.

Reliford made a motion to accept the lawn maintenance bid from MAAS LAWN SERVICE @ \$80.00 per cut with not more than 30 cuts per year, 4 clean up at \$45.00 each and trimming shrubs, clean flower bed and playground twice at \$30.00 each time. Total price \$2,640.00 for the season. This motion was supported by Heiden.

Tabled the "Entering Emmett Twp." signs until more information is gathered.

Planning commission report was given by Reliford. Supervisor Butler made it clear that all electronic or paper copy information used in communication by the Planning Commission needs to be transmitted to the Township Clerk's Office.

Brown made a motion to refuse the right to purchase the Tax foreclosure property of .8 acre that was sent to our Township by the County Treasurer. Heiden supported. Motion carried.

Brown made a motion to adjourn the meeting, supported by Heiden. Meeting was adjourned at 7:59 p.m.
