Resolution #26-08: INVESTMENT AND DEPOSITORY DESIGNATION, was accepted with a motion by Butler and support by Kot.

Resolution #26-09: INVESTMENT & DEPOSITORY AUTHORIZATION, was accepted with a motion by Butler and supported by Jackson.

Supervisor Butler presented two work orders from the St. Clair County Road Commission to the Board. Butler made a motion to accept the first work order for 100 loads of limestone at 56 ton/load at \$28.41/ton for an overall cost of \$159,096.00. K. Scott supported the motion.

Butler made a motion to approve the second work order for 89,300 gallons of chloride for various roads at a cost of \$23,218.00. Support was given by Reliford. Roll call: K. Scott; Yea, Butler; Yea, Reliford; Yea, Kot; Yea, and Jackson; Yea. Motion passed.
