

EMMETT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
SPECIAL MEETING
April 27, 2026

The special board of trustees meeting was called to order by the supervisor at 9:30 a.m. and was followed by the pledge to the flag.

Roll call was taken with K. Scott, Reliford, Kot, Jackson, present and Butler present by speaker phone. K. Scott was given authority to run the meeting due to the Supervisor not being present in person.

Treasurer Kot presented the fire and road millage renewal language to the Board. The millages are to renew and increase back up to 1 mill, the expired previously voted in road and fire millages.

Resolution 26-14: RESOLUTION TO ADOPT MILLAGE RENEWAL BALLOT LANGUAGE FOR ROAD IMPROVEMENTS was accepted with a motion by Jackson and support by K. Scott.

Roll call: K. Scott; Yea, Reliford; Yea, Kot; Yea, Jackson; Yea, and Butler; Yea. Motion passed.

Butler made a motion to approve the work order for a cross road culvert repair of \$3,000 on Imlay City Road. Support was given by Kot.

Roll call: Kot; Yea, Jackson; Yea, Butler; Yea, K. Scott; Yea, and Reliford; Yea. Motion passed.

Butler made a motion to add 3 more loads of limestone to the 2026 Township limestone haul. Two loads will be reimbursed to the Township by Harold Green. Jackson seconded the motion.

Roll call: Jackson; Yea, Butler; Yea, K. Scott; Yea, Reliford; Yea, and Kot; Yea. Motion passed.

Butler made a motion to adjourn the meeting and was supported by Reliford. The meeting was adjourned at 10:00 a.m. Motion carried.
